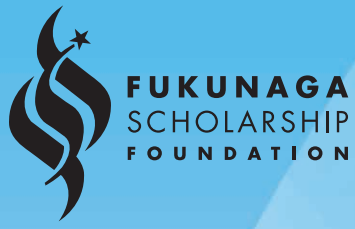


OUR 2011 - 2012 SCHOLARSHIP RECIPIENTS



FUKUNAGA SCHOLARSHIP FOUNDATION RECIPIENTS

The Fukunaga Scholarship Foundation was founded in 1950. Every year, over \$150,000 in scholarships is given to encourage students in the State of Hawaii to pursue a higher education in business administration or a related area. Each undergraduate scholarship is in the amount of \$16,000 over four years (or a prorated amount over fewer years). The Foundation awards scholarships to the most deserving applicants on the basis of financial need, academic standing, leadership ability and the commitment to pursue a degree in business. This year, 10 students are new recipients of scholarships. We currently have 43 students in our scholarship program. Over its 61-year history, the Foundation has helped support over 400 students.

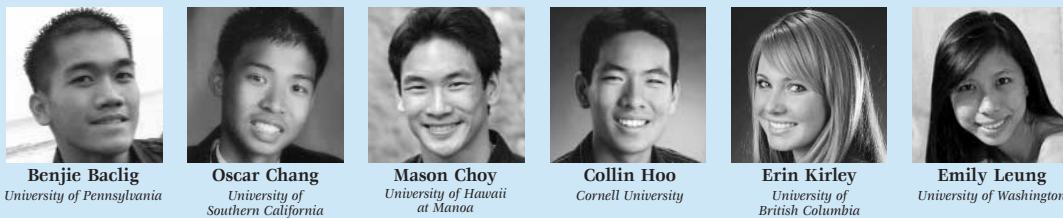

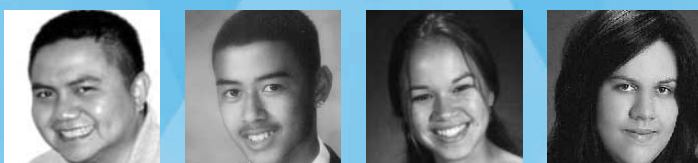
SERVCO FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIP RECIPIENTS
